Dear Fellow,

In reference to your email dated 04.10.2020 (trailing below), regarding the leave tenure criteria for ICMR-JRF, it is to inform you that the Competent Authority of ICMR has already issued an **Order no. 16/139/2014-Admin.II dated 11.06.2019** (enclosed, see page no. 2) in accordance with the **latest DST order no. SR/S9/Z-08/2018 dated 30/01/2019** (copy enclosed), **which states the "JRF/SRF are only eligible to avail casual leaves"**.

Therefore, as per the above ICMR order, all ICMR-JRF/SRFs in all 27 ICMR Institutes will be eligible to avail only eight (08) casual leaves (CL) as per ICMR rules.

NOTE: The same will be shortly updated on ICMR-website also for notification to all.
